SCHREINER FINE JEWELLERY

The internationally acclaimed German brand will be showcasing its bejewelled repertoire for the first time in Asia. Founded in Munich in 1988 and known for its fine, handmade pieces, it will showcase a splendid haute joaillerie collection of diamonds and precious gems, including a stunning Burmese drop-down ruby necklace. Known too for its innovative jewellery, this is the brand with the iconic Buddha-cut diamonds, which are, yes, diamonds shaped like serene Buddha figures. These, along with Schreiner's innovative processes, will also be displayed. schreiner-jewellery.com

MOUAWAD

Serving royalty and modern-day celebrities since 1890, Mouawad is an established player in the jewellery industry. Apart from at its Palais Renaissance boutique in Singapore, fans and collectors alike will get to lay eyes on the brand's mesmerising pieces at the fair. Sure to be a crowd-puller is its breathtaking necklace in 18k white gold with three brilliant Colombian emeralds — a 36.56-ct step-cut, a 10.19-ct pear-shaped and a 12.05-ct fancy-cut — surrounded by diamonds totalling 176.457-ct. mouawad.com


HEINZ MAYER

German brands continue to dazzle with this Idar-Oberstein-based label joining Singapore JewelFest 2014's eminent line-up. With its roots in diamond and gemstone-cutting, the jeweller to European royalty — whose clientele also boasts names such as Harry Winston — is famed for pieces that are resplendent in colour and gleam. The brand is also known for its patented Rolling Diamonds line of tennis bracelets that are so lustrous that they have been called "champagne for your wrists". Each section of the bracelet is individually joined with a special patented hinge, resulting in flexibility and durability. heinzmayer.de



ZYDO

The Italian brand's pieces are favourites with red-carpet celebrities (such as Blake Lively and Carrie Underwood) and certainly, popular with jewellery aficionados. It is known for exclusively designing, sampling and producing pieces entirely in its factory located in the city of Valenza. We predict that this magnificent diamond necklace — glorious with pear-shaped, marquise and round diamonds in 18k white gold — will be one of the favourites at the show. zydo.it



HANS D KRIEGER FINE JEWELLERY

Just shy of its third centenary, German jewellery brand Hans D Krieger has long impressed with its superb quality and diamonds that range in colours, cuts and carat sizes. Its oeuvre can be traced back to its long-held practice of manufacturing its own jewellery in-house. Rough stones are selected — pristine white or natural colours — then cut and polished, following which are incorporated into designs. A fine example of its fine craftsmanship may be viewed in the voluptuous diamond and ruby ring (2.03-ct), where 10 glittering diamonds are set surrounding the luscious, brilliant red stone. krieger.net.com
